

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Indian Health Service and Tribal Engineering Department have done planning and assessment work to determine water and wastewater system needs for all Fort Apache Indian Reservation communities; and

**WHEREAS,** this planning work has considered funding sources, future growth, alternative projects, the near-term Apache Dawn housing project and other factors; and

**WHEREAS,** the community water and wastewater system needs and costs identified through this work not presently addressed by the Tribe and IHS include the following:

Cedar Creek water system	\$ 825,000
Cedar Creek wastewater system	373,438
South Cibecue water system	211,875
South Cibecue wastewater system	358,750
East Fork/Turkey Creek water system	373,750
East Fork/Turkey Creek wastewater system	1,608,825
Hon-Dah water system	2,686,250
Hon-Dah wastewater system	<u>3,886,000</u>
TOTAL	\$10,321,888


**WHEREAS,** the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development Agency, has been a financial supporter on past water and wastewater projects on the Reservation whereby Rural Development is accepting applications for additional tribal projects.

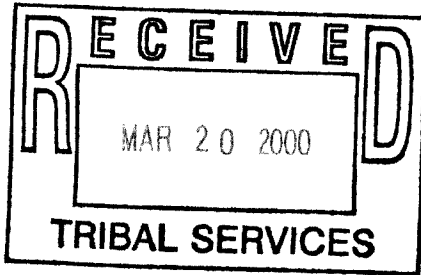
**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Tribal Planning and Engineering Department, working with IHS and the Tribal Housing Authority, to prepare applications to meet the above shown needs for water and wastewater system improvements on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman or his designee is authorized to sign application documents, but that submitting applications to Rural Development for determination of eligibility does not obligate the Tribe to accept funds or to proceed without further Tribal Council direction.

The foregoing resolution was on February 18, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (i), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
