## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Resolution No. 11-90-258 exist which states the Tribal Council's desire to contract for Fiscal Year 1991 and each year thereafter for Health Authority Management Unit, Health Education, Community Health Representatives, Residential Alcohol Treatment Program, Emergency Medical Services, Mental Health Services, Aftercare Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Patient Transportation Program is to be included in the FY 2000 White Mountain Apache Health Authority/Indian Health Services contract and future renegotiated contracts; and
- WHEREAS, the three year term for the existing Patient Transportation Program contracts is expiring this year and the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires contract mature status be established for the Patient Transportation Program.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Patient Transportation Program is to be included in negotiated Health Authority Contract for FY2000 and future years.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that FY2000 Patient Transportation Contract be established to mature status.

The foregoing resolution was on March 31, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (k), (l), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
