FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

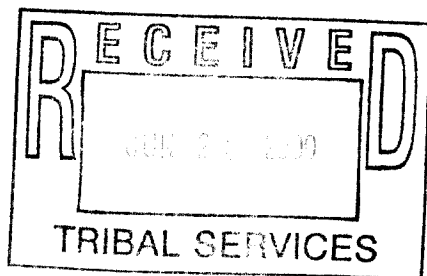
WHEREAS, Tribal Council Chairman Dallas Massey, Sr. has advised that Thursday, May 4, 2000, is National Prayer Day throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to recognize this important day within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports and recognizes the power of prayer for our lives and our families.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares this Thursday, May 4, 2000 as National Prayer Day within the lands of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
