RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that Tribal Member Vonda Clarkson continues to be hospitalized in Tucson, Arizona; and
- WHEREAS, the Clarkson family has been assisted financially through fund raising activities sponsored by family and friends; and
- WHEREAS, all funds have been exhausted in assisting the Clarkson family with travel, meals and hotel expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council would like to assist the family financially in the amount of \$1,000 to help cover expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the family may need future financial assistance because of the significant travel, housing and medical needs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assists the Clarkson family in the amount of \$1,000 for expenses resulting from the hospitalization of Vonda Clarkson in Tucson, Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this award of money will not make the Clarkson family eligible for future assistance due to the significant burden of travel, housing and medical costs resulting from Mrs. Clarkson's illness and hospitalization.

The foregoing resolution was on May 1, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
