

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has, in Executive Session this day, heard from Tribal member Valarie Crews regarding KNNB scholarship; and

**WHEREAS,** Ms. Crews states that she was awarded a scholarship over one year ago but has yet to receive funds; and

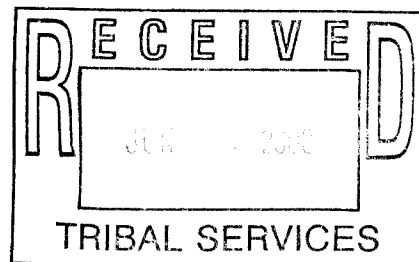
**WHEREAS,** the delay in payment has affected her financial aid support by \$500.00 for two consecutive semesters as she had to report the scholarship award regardless of nonpayment; and

**WHEREAS,** KNNB Station Manager has explained the delay in payment and verified that Ms. Crews did apply for the scholarship and was selected, and agrees that she should be awarded; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council agrees that Ms. Crews should receive her due scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 for two semesters, plus reimbursement for travel expenses and a letter of apology from KNNB Station Manager.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$1,000 from KNNB for Ms. Crews scholarship, plus reimbursement for travel expenses and a letter of apology from KNNB Station Manager to Ms. Crews.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
