FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

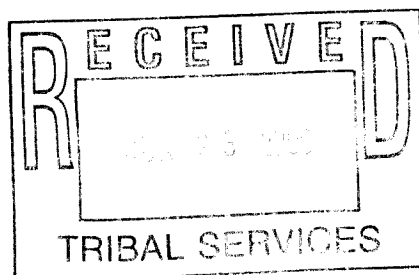
WHEREAS, Tribal member Annette Zahgotah has come before the Tribal Council this date to request assistance in having her home moved from the Seven Mile community to the East Fork community; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Zahgotah was advised to file a home site application through the Land Office, as well as with the Tribal Plan and Project Review office; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves Ms. Zahgotah's request and directs appropriate Tribal departments to assist her in moving her home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs appropriate Tribal departments to assist Annette Zahgotah in moving her home.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
