RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed prior Resolution No. 04-2000-124 awarding a tribal vehicle to Herbert Tate in recognition of his departure from the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Resolution was adopted by the Tribal Council as a walk-through resolution; and
- WHEREAS, several Council Members have indicated they were not made aware of the resolution and they did not have the opportunity to vote on the resolution; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the manner in which the resolution was presented and adopted does not conform to good legislative procedure, and has the appearance of an eleventh hour attempt to seek Council approval of a measure without full review and discussion; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it wishes to prevent this type of practice from occurring in the future; and
- WHEREAS, on this basis the Tribal Council wishes to rescind the effect of Resolution 04-2000-124.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that on this date it hereby rescinds Resolution 04-2000-124 awarding a Jeep Cherokee, tribal vehicle, to former Council member Herbert Tate, and on that basis hereby directs that the vehicle be returned ownership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it become the policy of this body that all resolutions, whether in open meeting, closed meeting, or a walk-through resolution be presented to all Tribal Council Members, when possible, to insure that all actions of the Council are open to input and discussion from all Council Members, when reasonably possible.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it implements a ban on further gifts of Tribal property to outgoing office holders of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and TWO

against and <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
