

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** a Tribal Member and TANF client informed the Tribal Council of her concerns on this program; and

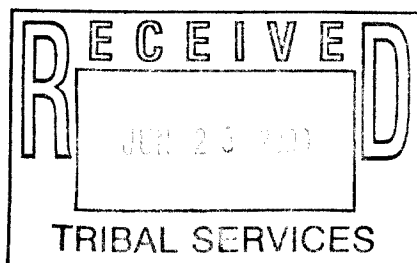
**WHEREAS,** she emphasized that the computer training classes were ceased and requests that these classes continue for TANF client's to become self-sufficient; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has been notified by the Tribal Social Services Director that funds were received from the State Legislature in the amount of \$73,900 with plans for use of these funds identified; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council agrees that continued computer training for TANF clients would be beneficial and concurs that part of stated funds be utilized for this purpose.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports continued computer training for TANF clients and that funds be utilized for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
