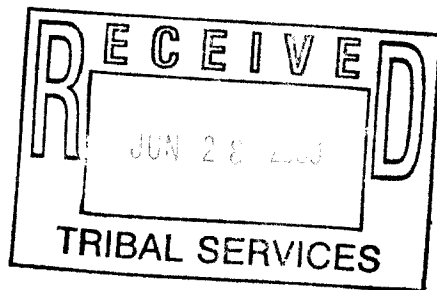
WHEREAS, by virtue of the powers listed in the Tribal Constitution and the Tribal Council's inherent authority to appropriate tribal funds for tribal purposes and to regulate its own procedures and to act on matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, the East Fork Crown Dance Group has been requested to perform during the Mescalero Apache Tribe's Fourth of July celebration to be held July 1 through July 5, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the East Fork Crown Dance group has requested \$500 in assistance from Tribal Council to defray expenses for 11 people to travel on a trip to Mescalero, New Mexico.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the allocation of \$500 to the East Fork Crown Dance group to help defray the travel expense for this group to travel to New Mexico..

The foregoing resolution was on June 21, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
