## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, members of the American Legion Post No. 60 have come before the Tribal Council this day; and
- WHEREAS, they have informed the Tribal Council of the need to transport Veterans to medical appointments and other activities but that they lack transportation; and
- WHEREAS, the group also shared concerns on the lack of a building to conduct their meetings; and
- WHEREAS, the American Legion Post No. 60 members request the return of their van and the use of a building.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the Veterans and approves the return of the white, Ford 15-passenger van.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby allows the American Legion Post No. 60 to utilize the Elderly Home building on a temporary basis while efforts are made to find a suitable site for the American Legion.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 13, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
