WHEREAS, Michael J. Brown has come before the Tribal Council to seek support for his effort to be elected as the Navajo County Superior Court Judge – Div. III; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs to support and endorse Mr. Brown for stated position.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the candidacy of Michael J. Brown as the Navajo County Superior Court Judge – Div. III and grants him permission to post political signs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 13, 2000</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for, <u>TWO</u> against and <u>TWO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
