

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Becky Ethelbah on behalf of Johns Hopkins University Pathways has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve for publications the Pathways manuscript Patterns of Physical Activity Among American Indian Children: An Assessment of Barriers and Support; and

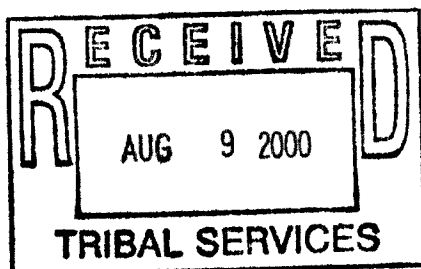
**WHEREAS,** this manuscript reports on formative assessment data collected as related to patterns, supports and barriers to physical activity. This formative information was collected in the feasibility phase of the Pathways study that include eight (8) different schools and six (6) different tribes. This information was used to design culturally and age-appropriate, practical interventions for school children in the Pathways study; and

**WHEREAS,** this manuscript examines data collected as part of the feasibility Pathways study. Data collected from the eight schools was used to design an age appropriate physical activity intervention; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval to have this manuscript published.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves publication of Pathways manuscript Patterns of Physical Activity Among American Indian Children: An Assessment of Barriers and Support.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
