

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is entrusted to serve and represent its members; and

WHEREAS, education continues to be a high priority for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Higher Education has been designated as the primary agency for higher educational concerns for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Arizona State University (ASU) has established the Native American Achievement Program (NAAP) in order to develop a strong foundation for White Mountain Apache Tribal Scholarship recipients attending ASU to foster both academic and personal success by providing student and academic support services within the ASU community; and

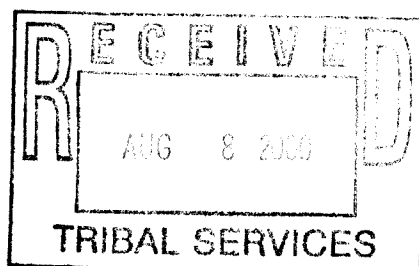
WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and ASU recognize the need to facilitate and coordinate a system within the higher education structure to assist White Mountain Apache students to gain access to higher education opportunities and to address retention of White Mountain Apache students in higher education in Arizona; and



WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to partner with ASU and participate in the NAAP in an effort to address retention and higher educational concerns for White Mountain Apache students attending ASU.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Arizona Board of Regents for and on behalf of Arizona State University and the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves of the guidelines contained in the attached intergovernmental agreement between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Arizona State University.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
