

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** Jerry Brownlow, a Democrat, has come before the Tribal Council to seek support for his effort to be elected as the Navajo County Supervisor for District 5; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council acknowledges that Mr. Brownlow and his wife, Coleen Brownlow have lived within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for several years and have provided services to Tribal members; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council believes it only proper to support members of the local communities within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation who run for political office and who have acted in good will toward the Tribe and its members; and


**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council also has endorsed Mr. Larry Vicario, the Republic candidate and incumbent for the Navajo County Board of Supervisors for District 5, for the same reason that he has also assisted the Tribe and its members in his capacity as the incumbent.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports Mr. Jerry Brownlow in his campaign for the Navajo County Board of Supervisors for District 5.

The foregoing resolution was on September 20, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
