**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

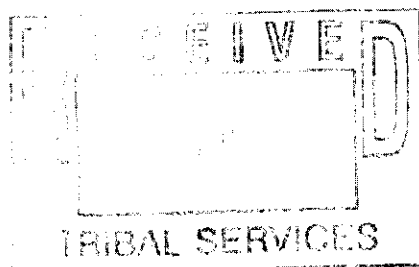
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that Dhanielle Declay, an enrolled Tribal Member, will be participating in the Miss Indian Teen World National Scholarship Pageant 2000-2001; and

WHEREAS, the family has requested financial assistance in the amount of \$2,500.00 to help defray costs associated with the pageant; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs to assist Ms. Declay with requested financial assistance with \$250.00 from Council Member Noland Clay's Public Relations Account, \$1,250.00 to be shared by the Executive Offices of the Chairman and Vice Chairman and \$1,000.00 to be donated from Hondah Casino.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assists Dhanielle Declay in the amount of \$2,500.00 with \$250.00 from Council Member Noland Clay's Public Relations Account, \$1,250.00 to be split by the Executive Offices of the Chairman and Vice Chairman and \$1,000.00 from Hondah Casino.

The foregoing resolution was on October 4, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
