FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

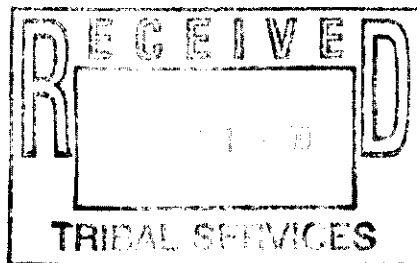
WHEREAS, Tribal member Jackie Altaha, on behalf of her daughter, the newly crowned Miss Indian Teen World Dhanielle DeClay, has informed the Tribal Council of the many invitations Danielle has received to date; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Altaha stated that in order to accept these invitations, fundraising activities will need to be held to help defray traveling costs; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Altaha has requested waivers for costs for usage of the Aday Memorial Hall and the Exhibit Hall for the purpose of holding fundraising activities for Miss Indian Teen World Dhanielle DeClay.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval for waivers for the Aday Memorial Hall and the Exhibit Hall use for Miss Indian Teen World Dhanielle DeClay to hold her fundraising activities.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 2000, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
