

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a request of support from the Navajo Nation in regards to the federal pardon of their former leader Peter McDonald, Sr.; and
- WHEREAS, the people of the Navajo Nation have forgiven Mr. McDonald for his crimes and feel that he has served a substantial amount of his sentence; and
- WHEREAS, due to his rapidly declining health, the Navajo Nation feels that this federal pardon be granted by the President of the United States Bill Clinton and that the former leader be returned to his homelands in order to return harmony and peace to the Navajo people; and
- WHEREAS, the Navajo Nation has asked for the support of other Indian tribes in this request.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the request from the people of the Navajo Nation for a federal pardon for their former leader Peter McDonald, Sr.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
