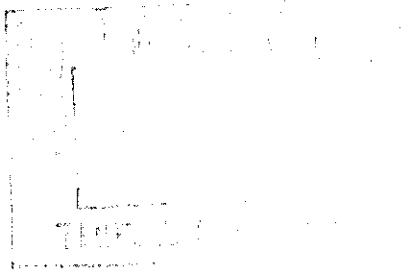

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council in Resolution 12-2000-346 has created a vacancy in the position of Chief Judge at the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Honorable Durango Fall, Juvenile Court Judge, and current Acting Chief Judge has been recommended to fill the vacancy; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to the Tribal Judicial Code, Section 2.13 Mr. Durango would fill the remaining term for Chief Judge Marjorie Grimes, through May, 2002; and
- WHEREAS,** Judge Fall is widely regarded and respected for his ability and integrity and would serve the Tribe well as its Chief Judge of the Tribal Court

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the Honorable Durango Fall as Chief Judge of the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the term of such appointment to be for the remainder of the term of the current vacant position of Chief Judge, concluding in May, 2002.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 2000 duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
