RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed employment problems on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Council has received many concerns and complaints regarding the high level of non-Tribal Member employment on the reservation at Indian Health Service, the Bureau of Indian Affairs and local schools; and
- WHEREAS, due to concerns and complaints of the Tribal Members, the Tribal Council wishes to reaffirm Resolution No. 01-87-24 which enacted Ordinance No. 151 which states that there shall be a hiring preference for White Mountain Apache tribal members for any employer within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 01-87-24 in its entirety and requests that I H S, BIA and local schools comply with these mandates.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 03, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
