RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Bo Ellis Skidmore requests the use of the FATCO baseball field; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Skidmore is willing to repair the field for use by the Whiteriver community little league team; and
- WHEREAS, as ownership status of stated field is uncertain, Mr. Skidmore is advised to check with Raymus Albert of the Tribal Land Office for clarification; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs to allow Bo Ellis Skidmore the use of the FATCO baseball field upon land status review by Raymus Albert of the Tribal Land Office.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Mr. Bo Ellis Skidmore the use of the FATCO baseball field for the Whiteriver community little league upon certification from Mr. Raymus Albert of the Tribal Land Office that the FATCO baseball field is available for public use.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 5, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
