RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Roads Committee is in receipt of the Federal Register, January 9, 2001, which allows "tribal capacity building funds" to be made available to tribal governments; and

WHEREAS, this funding is made available to Tribes with the following stipulations:

- 1. Scope of work;
- 2. Budget;
- 3. Tribal resolution in support of the funding; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Roads Committee has reviewed the requirements and has agreed to comply with this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Regional Office secure funds for tribal capacity building as stated in the Federal Register dated January 9, 2001.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 21, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
