

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the position of Juvenile Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court is currently vacant; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.9 of the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council has the responsibility of appointing Tribal Court Judges based upon nominations; and
- WHEREAS, tribal member Georgina Stover has been nominated for the judiciary and meets all the qualifications set forth in the Judicial Code to serve as a Juvenile Judge; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that Ms. Stover has the wisdom and compassion to effectively serve as a Juvenile Judge.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Georgina Stover as Juvenile Judge of the Tribal Court.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Section 2.13 of the Judicial Code, that Georgina Stover shall serve the remainder of the four-year term formerly held by Juvenile Judge Durango and ending on May 15, 2002.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 14, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against and <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
