**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

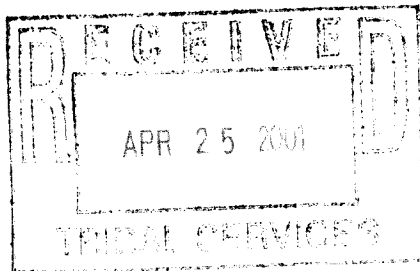
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by Council Member Phoebe Nez of a request to utilize the Nagle Ranch for a June wedding; and

WHEREAS, this request has been approved by the Wildlife & Outdoor & Recreation Division.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Frank Larzelere family permission to use Nagle Ranch for the wedding of Mark McGuckin which will take place on June 16, 2001 and such permission for use is restricted to the date of June 16, 2001.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Mark McGuckin and guests at the wedding shall not use or caused to be used, nor provide any part of the Nagle Ranch for any unlawful conduct or purpose or for any purpose unrelated to that which is permitted herein, and Mark McGuckin and guests shall not do or permit to be done in or about the Nagle Ranch, nor bring, keep or permit to be brought or kept herein, anything which is prohibited by or will in any way conflict with any law, statute, ordinance, compact, agreement or governmental rule or regulation now enforced or which may hereafter be enacted or promulgated governing Mark McGuckin's use of the Nagle Ranch.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
