WHEREAS, Tribal member Abilene Griggs has informed the Tribal Council of academic achievements and community service input by Marcus Burnette, Crystal and Raquel Griggs; and

WHEREAS, the three students were selected to attend a national conference in Hawaii as recognition of their scholastic and community service achievements; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Griggs has requested financial assistance to help defray travel costs.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to assist with this financial request as per guidelines set for student assistance.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 4, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
