RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, convening on April 4, 2001 for Tribal member requests, received Pam Lupe's request for a small business license to operate a clothing and shoe retail business; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for small business enterprises within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to provide essential services and goods to residents of the Reservation to reduce the amount of travel, expense and inconveniences that Tribal members must incur by going off the reservation to obtain these services.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to issue a business license to Pam Lupe effective on this day, for the purposes of operating a clothing and shoe retail business that will service residents of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 4, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
