## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a request from Milson Cromwell to regain his employment at the White Mountain Apache Tribe Public Works Department after being released from his employment for reasons which he believes are not accurate; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has heard from Alfred Brooks, Director of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Public Works Department on the reason why he released Mr. Cromwell from employment; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after hearing from Milson Cromwell and Alfred Brooks believe that the incidents surrounding Mr. Cromwell's release from employment are questionable and therefore Mr. Cromwell should still be considered for employment at Public Works for positions of mechanic or heavy equipment operator for which Mr. Cromwell's experience and qualifications are suitable.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based upon the information it received this day, it hereby directs the Chairman to send a letter to Alfred Brooks directing him to place Milson Cromwell on the immediate hire list for future full time or temporary mechanic and heavy equipment operator positions available at Public Works.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 4, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
