

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has authorized the Rainbow Treatment Center to provide substance abuse treatment services throughout the reservation; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to provide the most effective services, Rainbow Center has established the objective of continuing evaluation of its treatment services through monitoring the progress of current and former clients through a process known as Outcomes Management; and

**WHEREAS**, Rainbow Center is currently in the process of becoming certified by a national accrediting agency for rehabilitation services; and

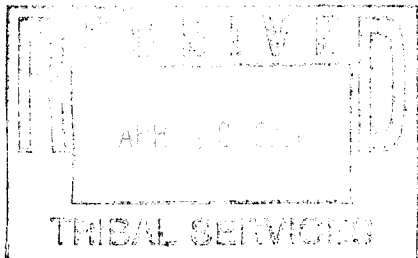
**WHEREAS**, Indian Health Services has announced the availability of grant monies in order to plan and implement an Outcomes Management system that would allow Rainbow Center to fulfill its goals in this area; and


**WHEREAS**, the Rainbow Center Director has requested permission to apply for the IPS grant for funding to implement the outcome study.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Director to pursue the Tribal Management Grant/Program Evaluation Component offered by the Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Services, and Indian Health Services to assist Rainbow Center in meetings its goal of providing the best quality treatment available to its clients.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes an in-kind match in the amount of \$50,000 through services, staff time, and other resources for the program costs to fulfill the grant conditions.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 2001 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
