

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Bruce Lee Shaw, dob: 10/25/1982, son of Esther Shaw, has requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment with the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community; and
- WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of head rights was signed by Bruce Lee Shaw in the presence of a Notary Public on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2001, and are attached hereto; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Enrollment Committee approved this relinquishment request at their meeting on February 27, 2001.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Bruce Lee Shaw and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is relinquished as of this date along with any and all privileges accorded members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe such as, but not limited to hunting, fishing, and recreational privileges within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of Vital Records to remove Bruce Lee Shaw from the membership rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article II, Section 2 and Article IV, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
