

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Carrizo Community President Gillespie Childs, Jr. and Vice President Lavinia Ross have informed the Tribal Council of difficulties encountered for community members to sell food and soda at the Carrizo junction store; and
- WHEREAS, these community members have obtained Food Handlers Permits in order to sell food; and
- WHEREAS, they are asking the Tribal Council to allow their fellow community members permission to sell food items and soda near the Carrizo junction store.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby allows the Carrizo community members permission to sell food items and soda near the Carrizo junction store.

The foregoing resolution was on May 10, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
