

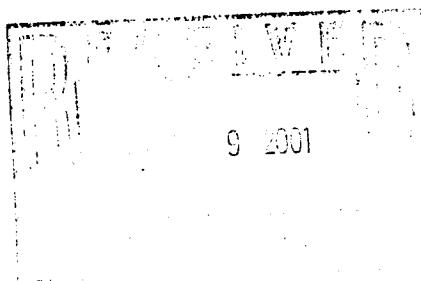
**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Adult Education Program promotes educational programming for tribal members (16 years and older) not served by traditional education through GED preparatory and Basic Skills classes and networks which to promote life long learning skills; and
- WHEREAS,** educational opportunities and learning experiences are provided through programs and relationships established by tribal state, federal and other organizations, agencies and Groups; and
- WHEREAS,** a Memorandum of Understanding between Northland Pioneer College and the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Tribal Education Management program, will strengthen the Adult Education Program's effectiveness to reach more Tribal members and enhance the opportunity of participants to gain employment which is a goal to a positive lifestyle; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Education Director to develop, plan, negotiate and administer new programs and contracts, and/or any amendments thereof for the continuing improvement of educational opportunities and services provided tribal members.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Education Director to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding between Northland Pioneer College and White Mountain Apache Tribe, Tribal Education management office which is effective June 1, 2001, to June 30, 2002, as presented to the Council this day.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the effective date of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be June 1, 2001 and will terminate June 30, 2002, at which time the Council will consider granting an extension of the Memorandum of Understanding.

The foregoing resolution was on May 17, 2001 duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
