- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Eileen Pike, on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Youth Council, has informed the Tribal Council of plans for seven (7) high school students to attend the 2001 National UNITY Conference in Grand Rapids, Michigan to from June 29 July 3, 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the conference offers educational experiences designed to promote alcohol and drug prevention, safety issues, education, and other youth-related issues; and
- **WHEREAS**, fundraising efforts have been attempted with no success, therefore, \$2,400.00 is requested to purchase airline tickets for the students.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$2,400.00 to purchase airline tickets for seven (7) students to attend the UNITY Conference.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
