

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council rescinds Resolution No. 04-2001-115; and
- WHEREAS, the Native Vision Sports and Life Skills Camp will be held on June 22, 23, and 24, 2001 for a second year on the White Mountain Apache Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, this camp offers the youth positive experiences along with life skills training and education; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recommends that a barbecue be held during the camp as an offer of appreciation and farewell from the White Mountain Apache Tribe to all Native Vision personnel and participants.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves \$5,000.00 for an appreciation barbecue to be held for the 2001 Native Vision Sports and Life Skills Camp.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Miss Indian World Kealoha May Cody Alo be designated to help coordinate the barbecue.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 12, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
