

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that two non-tribal member spouses of tribal members have passed away-Tom Johnson, spouse of Faith Beatty-Johnson and Edward Jensen, spouse of Flora Ethelbah-Jensen; and

WHEREAS, the families request that these two be buried on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends its sincere sympathies to the families and grants approval for the two individuals to be buried on the White Mountain Apache Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 2, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
