## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal youth Dillene Hoffman, Harrisen DeClay and Felicita Lupe along with youth advisor Eileen Pike have expressed their concerns to return the Youth Center to the youth; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 06-2001-146 authorized a lease agreement between the Tribe and Northern Arizona Academy for the use of the Whiteriver Youth Center complex for up to two years, with a one year renewal by the mutual consent of the parties following the first term; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council after listening to the youth, concurs to rescind Resolution No. 06-2001-146 and returns the Youth Center to the youth.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution No. 06-2001-146.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Youth to utilize the Whiteriver Youth Center complex pursuant to the terms with occupation and use to be endorsed through the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 18, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
