

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Wanda Burnette has informed the Tribal Council that she is on a medical waiting list to receive a lung transplant; and
- WHEREAS, the surgery is to be performed in Denver, Colorado, after which she will need to be hospitalized there for three months; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Burnette requests the tribe's assistance with transportation and financial assistance to cover meals and lodging expenses for her and a family member.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves assistance to Ms. Burnette with transportation to and from Denver, Colorado.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it approves financial assistance in the amount of \$1,500.00 to cover meals and lodging expenses for Wanda Burnette and a family member to travel to Denver, Colorado for Ms. Burnette's lung transplant surgery.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 1, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
