

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Becky Ethelbah, on behalf of Johns Hopkins University, Pathways, has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve the Pathways manuscript for publication entitled: "Impact of the Pathways Intervention on Dietary Intakes of American Indian School Children"; and
- WHEREAS, the manuscript examines the Pathways intervention to successfully reduce the intake of percent of calories from fat and saturated fat, at least at school lunch and probably over the whole day; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval to have this manuscript published.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves for publication the Pathways Manuscript entitled, "Impact of the Pathways Intervention on Dietary Intakes of American Indian School Children".

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 1, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
