

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Becky Ethelbah, on behalf of Johns Hopkins University, Pathways, has approached the Tribal Council this date with a request that the Tribal Council approve the Pathways manuscript for publication entitled. "Changes in the Nutrient Content of School Lunches: Results from the Pathways Study"; and

WHEREAS, the Intervention documented the feasibility of successfully lowering the percent of calories from fat, as part of the coordinated obesity prevention program for American Indian children; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it should grant approval to have this manuscript published.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves for publication the Pathways Manuscript entitled, "Changes in the Nutrient Content of School Lunches: Results from the Pathways Study".

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 1, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
