## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, representatives from Master Yi's Arizona Taekwondo Center in Scottsdale have come before the Tribal Council with a proposal to begin a Taekwondo club in Whiteriver; and
- WHEREAS, the representatives have described the benefits for children and other young people from this international sport; and
- WHEREAS, the program could be incorporated into existing school programs within the Reservation and provide a positive outlet for students and a source of accomplishment and pride; and
- WHEREAS, the proposal would require no financial commitment on behalf of the Tribe, although assistance by the Tribe in providing transportation between the reservation and the Scottsdale Taekwondo center would be very valuable to assure that members of the center can attend the grand opening event for the club when it begins operation within Whiteriver; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council encourages the local schools to support this program and to make its resources available to the volunteers from the Taekwondo center to help improve the opportunities for our children; and
- WHEREAS, the school programs may also be able to meet the transportation requests submitted by the Taekwondo representatives.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports and endorses the request from Master Yei's Arizona Taekwondo Center in Scottsdale, Arizona to open a Taekwondo club in Whiteriver.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it request the full cooperation and commitment from the local schools to support the club activities within their existing facilities and to coordinate with each other to arrange for transportation and other preparation work for a grand opening event at a site within Whiteriver community for the club operations.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 2, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
