- WHEREAS, the statements made against Council member Craig pertain to her vote on the Tribe's annual budget, raising unfounded allegations for her vote on this important matter; and
- WHEREAS, Council member Craig has advised the Council that the statements were inaccurate and unfair; and
- WHEREAS, Council member Craig believes that she should be provided equal air time on KNNB to appropriate respond to the remarks made against her; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with this request.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request by Council member Mariddie J. Craig to have the opportunity for air time on KNNB radio in equal amount to air time provided for the Vice-Chairman during the comments he made about Council member Craig and her recent vote on the Tribal budget.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 2, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for, <u>ONE</u> against, and <u>ONE</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
