- WHEREAS, Tribal member Josh Anderson has informed the Tribal Council that he is a senior at Southern Utah University, majoring in Criminal Justice with a minor in Sociology, and will be graduating May 2002; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Anderson stated that he was approved for \$1,250.00 from Higher Education but that this amount is insufficient for school; therefore, he requests additional financial assistance to cover his education and living expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs to assist Josh Anderson with his financial request in the amount of \$1,250.00 for one semester based on his current student status.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to assist Josh Anderson in the amount of \$1,250.00 for one semester based on his current student status.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 15, 2001</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
