

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the central Tribal offices had previously adopted a compressed work schedule to complete a two-week 80 hour work period in nine working days; and

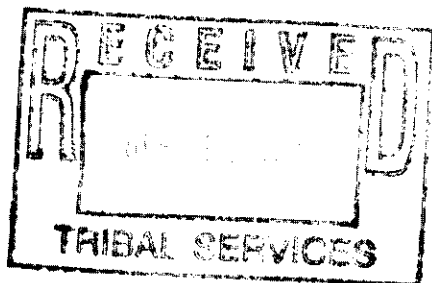
WHEREAS, this schedule resulted in the closure of tribal offices each pay-day Friday; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that this schedule be rescinded to restore normal working hours to five business days each week, with Tribal offices open on each Friday, including pay-day Fridays, with the exception of Tribal holidays.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves, effective September 4, 2001, the return to a forty hour work accrued over a period of five business days each week for central Tribe employees, with no closure on pay-day Fridays, as had been provided under the prior compressed schedule, Tribal holidays excluded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that any prior resolution which had authorized the compressed business schedule is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on August 28, 2001 duly adopted by a vote of THREE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
