## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, on January 5, 2000, Mrs. Roger Griggs came before the Tribal Council to request financial assistance during the term of the medical residency for her husband, Dr. Roger Griggs; and
- WHEREAS, in response to Mrs. Grigg's request the Tribal Council adopted Resolution 01-2000-02, which authorized financial support for Dr. Griggs for the period of his residency at a rate of \$7,000 per semester in exchange for consultation and other work for the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 01-2000-02, payments are pending for the remaining amount for the fall semester, 201 and the spring semester 2002; and
- WHEREAS, due to a change in personal circumstances, Mrs. Griggs has returned to the Tribal Council this day to request that Resolution 01-2000-02 be rescinded and further payments be terminated; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council after discussion with Mrs. Griggs in executive session agrees with this request.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby rescinds Resolution 01-2000-02, and on that basis directs that no further payments be made for Dr. Griggs as had been previously authorized.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 13, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
