

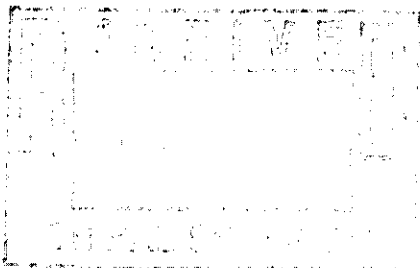
**RESOLUTION OF THE

**WHEREAS,** Raymus Albert, Land Board Director, has come before the Tribal Council this date requesting approval of the Land Board meeting minutes for August 23, 2001; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council, after review of the Land Board meeting minutes, agrees that the Land Board meeting minutes for August 23, 2001 should be approved as presented but to table #1 regarding home site request of 109 acres for 144 homes for nursing home facility employees.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Land Board meeting minutes for August 23, 2001 as presented.

The foregoing resolution was on September 14, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
