


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, convening on September 13, 2001 for Tribal member requests, received Harvey Lupe's request for a small business license to operate a laundromat and/or an arcade/café business in Cibecue; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for small business enterprises within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to provide essential services and goods to residents of the Reservation to reduce the amount of travel, expense and inconveniences that Tribal members must incur by going off the reservation to obtain these services.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Treasurer to issue a business license to Harvey Lupe effective on this day, for the purposes of operating a laundromat and/or an arcade/café business in Cibecue that will service residents of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
