## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS. Tribal member Gerald Bush has completed medical school at the University of Arizona and has begun his residency; and
- WHEREAS, during the term of his residency Dr. Bush will receive a modest salary in exchange for the training provided; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Bush received Tribal scholarships during his education, which concluded upon his graduation from medical school; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that Dr. Bush has requested financial support during the residency period which began in July 2000 and continues for three years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports the efforts of Dr. Bush and congratulates him on his success.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a stipend to Gerald Bush, M.D. in the amount of \$7,000 per semester for financial assistance to Dr. Bush during his residency in exchange for part-time consulting and assistance to the Tribe on medical related matters.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Health Authority to coordinate with Dr. Bush on the services he will provide to the Tribe in exchange for the \$7,000 per semester stipend.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs the Tribal Health Authority to document the services which Gerald Bush provides either through internal audit controls and procedures or through an invoice/billing system to ensure that expenditures of funds are properly documented.

## Resolution No. 11-2001-285

The foregoing resolution was on November 14, 2001, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by The Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
