RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has tribal members and non-tribal members that have disabilities that reside on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, people with disabilities have needs that are not being met one example in the following areas Fair Housing, Transportation, Advocacy; and
- WHEREAS, to help address the issues, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Vocational Rehabilitation Program will sponsor a Disability Awareness Week; and
- WHEREAS, activities will be planned throughout the week to address the needs of our population, including a Disability Awareness Fair with service providers present to help explain services that they provide.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares the week of February 11 15, 2002 as *Disability Awareness Week*.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 20, 2001</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s),(t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
