

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal member Carol George, on behalf of the Health Authority and Rainbow Treatment Center, has come before the Tribal Council this date to designate March 15, 2002 as a reservation-wide prayer walk day; and

WHEREAS, this event is to address alcohol and substance abuse on the reservation and for over-all healing for the tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council advises Ms. George to obtain special event permit from the Arizona Department of Transportation and approval from the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads for use of the road and the road shoulder during the walk; and

WHEREAS, the Council recommends that Ms. George obtain from the WMAT Police Department assistance in escorting the walk for safety purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates March 15, 2002 as a reservation-wide prayer walk day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that prior to conducting the walk on public roads through the Reservation, Carol George is directed to obtain all permits and assistance recommended herein and necessary to provide safe and proper use of public roads for pedestrian use.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
