

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has the power to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe and its members; and

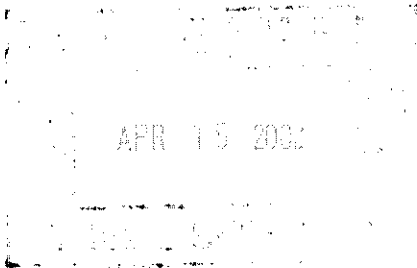
WHEREAS, the family of the late Officer Tenny Gatewood approached the Tribal Council this day with a request that the Council withhold its endorsement of any activity using the name and likeness of Officer Tenny Gatewood's name and likeness until the family has had the opportunity to provide comment to the Council on such use; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to honor and respect the selfless service and commitment exemplified through Officer Tenny Gatewood's ultimate sacrifice in protecting the peace of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and its residents and visitors by ensuring the proper utilization of his name and likeness as endorsed through his family.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it will abstain from approving any proposed use of Officer Tenny Gatewood's name and likeness until such time as the Gatewood family has formally notified their approval or disapproval of such use.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council Secretary shall provide notice to the Gatewood family - through Pearl Gatewood and Tim Gatewood - of proposed uses of Office Tenny Gatewood's name or likeness, and shall either schedule the appearance of such family representatives at the next duly called Council meeting or provide the Tribal Council copies of the families written response to such request.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
