

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, the 2002 Close Up Program students from Cibecue High School will be traveling to Washington, D.C. on March 9 through March 16, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the six students (Julee Dehose, Pamela Enriquez, Fernando Enriquez, Ferdina Dehose, Hortensia Sanchez, and Thaniel Tate) are requesting \$500.00 each to help defray expenses incurred; and


**WHEREAS**, there was a fundraising event held on March 4, 2002 at the Cibecue Elementary Gymnasium which raised \$600.00 and was sponsored by the Close Up students and parents; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council recognizes the 2002 Close Up Program students efforts and wholeheartedly supports them.

**WHEREAS**, monies in the amount of \$500.00 to each of the six students will be disbursed immediately as they will leave to Washington, D.C. on March 9, 2002.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the disbursement of \$500.00 per student for the six Close Up Program students identified above in order to participate in a school sponsored trip to Washington, D.C.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 2002 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
