

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, with the consistent support and encouragement of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and in full accord with the 1993 *Master Plan for the Fort Apache Historic Park, Nohwike' Bagowa*, The White Mountain Apache Cultural Center and Museum has made consistent progress toward the establishment of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as a recognized leader in the fields of community based cultural conservation, historic preservation, and tourism-oriented economic development; and

WHEREAS, The Arizona Commission on the Arts (A.C.A.) offers grant funding to support the operation of Tribal Museums in Arizona Native communities; and

WHEREAS, The Apache Culture Center has successfully participated in the Arizona Commission on the Arts Tribal Museum Program (ODP II) through the administration of annual grants to fund a professional Museum Director's position for 6 consecutive years.

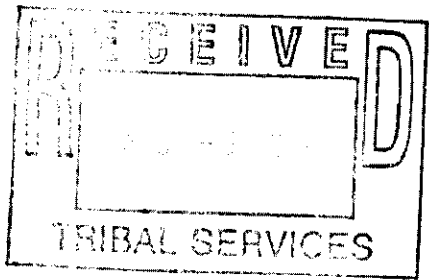
BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and endorses the *Nohwike' Bagowa* initiative to secure A.C.A. General Operating Support, ODP Level II/Tribal Museums grant support for 2002-2003.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints dr. Karl Hoerig, the Tribe's Museum Director, as the Tribe's agent to assist the Chairman in conducting all negotiations and in executing and submitting all documents, including application materials, billing statements, progress reports, etc., as required for the completion of ODP Level II/Tribal Museums grant support for 2002-2003.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that *Nohwike' Bagowa*, The White Mountain Apache Cultural Center and Museum is to comply fully with all applicable tribal, federal, and state regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements relating to the application and the resultant project.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 2002, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (g), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
